Welcome!!

Some NOTES before we start:

- A. British crochet terms are used throughout
- B. Have fun with this – create using as many or few colors as you like
- C. While you CAN replace the special stitches with more basic stitches, I highly recommend learning the stitches listed – they're very useful to know!

You will need....

90m 8ply/DK/#3 weight yarn

Yarn needle

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm

Gauge: 4 rows, 7 stitches in tr per 2"²

Techniques/abbreviations required...

Foundation Treble Crochet (Ftr) – (can replace with a chain of same number of stitches +3, then a row of tr, if desired)

Chainless Starting Treble Crochet (CStr) – (substitute for ch 3 throughout, if desired)

Treble Crochet (tr)

Half-Treble Crochet (htr)

Double Crochet (dc)

Chain (ch)

Slip Stitch (slst)

Skip (sk)

Stitch(es) (st, sts)

“V” – work tr, ch 1, tr into the indicated stitch

(For instructions and video tutorials on any of these techniques/stitches, I recommend Mooglyblog.com).

How to make (insert YOUR name here)'s Fancy Fingerless Gloves:

Make 2 the same. (My biggest tip is to work the two simultaneously (section by section), if you can):

- Round 1. **Ftr 20. Join to top of 1st tr with a slst. (20 Ftr)** (Adjustment for larger/smaller hands – add or remove multiples of 4 stitches, remembering to adjust the counts throughout).
- Round 2. CStr (counts as tr throughout).
Tr in each st around.
Join to top of CStr with a slst. (20 tr)
- Round 3. CStr.
* Sk next st.
“V” (tr, ch 1, tr) in next st.
Sk 1.
Tr in next st. **
Repeat * to ** around, skipping the last tr.
Join to CStr with a slst. (5 tr, 5 “V”)
- Round 4. CStr. (2nd tr of a “V”)
*Sk next st.
Tr into centre of “V” from previous round.
Sk next st.
“V” in next tr. **
Repeat * to ** around, skipping the last “V”.
Tr in same st as CStr.
Join to CStr with a htr – this will position your hook in the middle of the new “V”. (“V” formed). (5 tr, 5 “V”)
- Round 5. CStr.
**“V” in next tr.
Tr into centre of “V” from previous round. **
Repeat * to **, skipping last tr.
Join to top of CStr with a slst. (5 tr, 5 “V”)

Repeat Rounds 4 & 5 as often as you like, until the wrist section is your preferred length. I repeated them 2 more times, finishing on round 9.

Round 10. **Start of thumb hole.**
 CShtr (counts as htr throughout).
 Htr in each st and ch sp around.
DO NOT JOIN. (20 htr)
 Turn.

Rounds 10-13. Repeat round 10.

Round 14. CShtr.
 Htr in each st around.
 Join to top of CShtr with a slst to complete your thumb hole. (20 htr)

Round 15. Repeat Round 14. (20 htr)
Repeat Round 14 as often as you like, until the finger section is your preferred length. I repeated it 2 more times, finishing on round 17.

Round 18. Ch 1.
 Dc in same and each st around.
 Join to top of first dc with a slst. (20 dc)
 Cut yarn and tie off.

Finishing:

Sew in your ends and enjoy!
