# Dreamy Tracks Beanie

## Welcome!!

If you haven't done so already, please visit my shop [ReVe Design Co](#), where the best of my patterns are available to browse and order.

## Some NOTES before we start:

- UK crochet terms are used throughout
- The Dreamy Tracks Beanie is a customisable circle Hat that provides many styling options, but as written, will fit a medium lady's head
- Starting at the crown, you work in rounds until you get to the cuff. The cuff is worked last in Rows. This enables the creation of a button hole and flap
- Back Loop crochet stitches are used to create the texture. You can choose to work plain/normal double crochet stitches. Your result will be different to mine, yet still effective.

## You will need....

Approx. 120m DK weight yarn

5.5mm Crochet Hook

1 button 1"/2.5cm wide

Yarn needle

(Optional) Stitch marker to mark the start of each round

**Gauge:** Approx 7 sts and 6 rows in htr in 5cm(2")<sup>2</sup>

**Fit:** Designed to be a slightly slouchy fit, so a little longer than your head



## UK Techniques/abbreviations required:

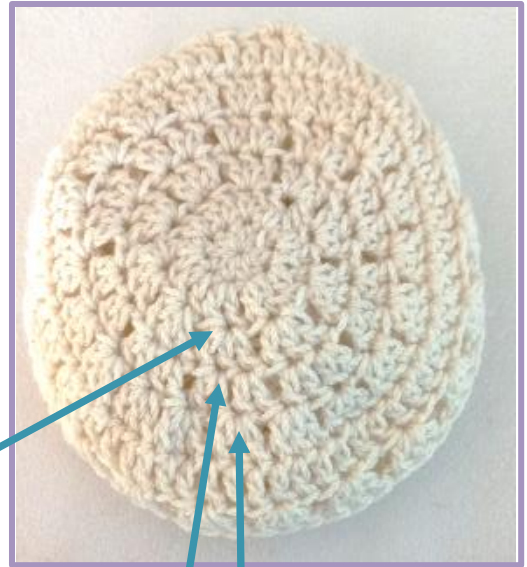
|                           |  |
|---------------------------|--|
| Magic Circle (mc)         | Back Loop Single Crochet (blsc) – work the single crochet into the back loop only    |
| Single Crochet (sc)       | 3-Treble Crochet Cluster (3-tr cluster) – work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch |
| Treble Crochet (tr)       | Turning Chain (tch) – NOT counted as a stitch  |
| Half Treble Crochet (htr) | Slip Stitch (slst)   |
| Chain (ch)                |  |

## How to make your Dreamy Tracks Beanie: Crown:

Working in rounds.

- Round 1. Mc. Tch.  
Htr 10 into circle.  
Pull mc tight then join to top of first htr with a slst. (10 htr)
- Round 2. Tch. Tr in 1<sup>st</sup> st.  
\*2 tr in next st\*\*  
Repeat \* to \*\* around.  
Work a 2<sup>nd</sup> tr into the first st.  
Join to top of first tr with a slst. (20 tr)
- Round 3. Tch. 2 Tr in 1<sup>st</sup> st.  
\*Sk 1. 3-tr cluster in next st. Sk 1\*\*  
Repeat \* to \*\* around.  
Work a 3<sup>rd</sup> tr into the first st.  
Join to top of first tr with a slst. (10 clusters (30 tr))
- Round 4. Tch. Tr in 1<sup>st</sup> st.  
\*Sk 1. 2 tr in next 2 sts (middle stitches of cluster)\*\*  
Repeat \* to \*\* around.  
Sk 1. Join to top of first tr with a slst. (40 tr)
- Round 5. Tch. 2 tr in 1<sup>st</sup> st.  
\*Sk 1. 3-tr cluster in next st (between the 2-tr clusters)\*\*.  
Repeat \* to \*\* around.  
Work a 3<sup>rd</sup> tr into the first st.  
Join to top of first tr with a slst. (20 clusters (60 tr))
- Round 6. Tch. Tr in each st around. (60 tr)



## Side:

- Round 7. Tch. 2 tr in 1st st.  
\*Sk 2. 3-tr cluster\*\*  
Repeat \* to \*\* around until 2 sts remain.  
Work a 3rd tr into the first st.  
Join to top of first tr with a slst. (20 3-tr clusters (60 tr))
- Round 8. Tch. Bldc in each st around.  
Join to 1st bldc with a slst. (60 bldc)
- Round 9. Tch.  
Bldc in each st around. Join to 1st bldc with a slst. (60 bldc)
- Rounds 10-18. Repeat rounds 7-9 three more times.
- Round 19. Repeat round 7.



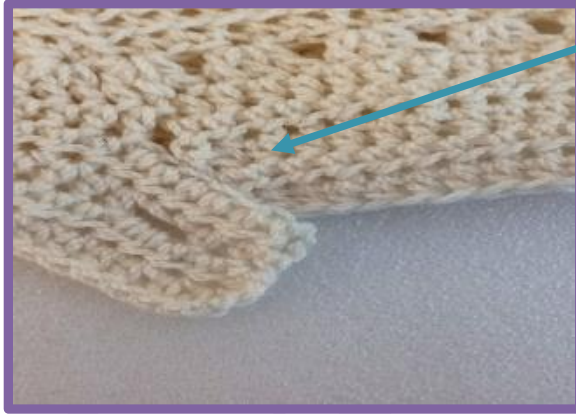
## Cuff:

- Row 1. Tch. Htr in each st around.  
Ch 8 (button tab).  
Turn. (60 htr. 8 ch)
- Row 2. Tch. Htr in each st.  
Turn. (68 htr)
- Row 3. Tch. Htr 63.  
**Form Button Hole** – Ch 2, sk 2. Htr in last 3 sts.  
Turn. (66 htr. 2 ch)
- Row 4. Tch.  
Htr 3. 2 htr in ch-2 sp. Htr to end.  
Turn. (68 htr)
- Row 5. Tch. Htr to end. Break yarn & fasten off. (68 htr)



## Finishing:

Step 1. Using your needle, sew your button a



few stitches from the end of your cuff. Fasten off.

Step 2. Sew in all ends.

Step 4. Make some more in other colors and ENJOY! 😊

Step 4. Look for more Dreamy Tracks designs! The Beanie with the matching Cowl and Mitts make a great casual set.
